It's well framed, with an intersectional approach; analyses how drug control has led to negative outcomes in terms of human rights violations. On health, it recognises that drug use is not always problematic and harm reduction involves not only interventions but also policies and practices; on prisons specifically, it addresses prison population as marginalised and underserved and harm reduction as a central part of the right to health. It pays quite a lot of attention to privacy and confidentiality. It also makes strong recommendations, though some topics deserve more development. Prisons are one of them; humanitarian settings is another one, but they will likely be covered in the next UNGA report.

The teport also mentions meaningful participation of people who use drugs in policymaking, that could be a good entry point to further address participation of patients.
