Interpretation

Definitions

- Account: A unique account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- Affiliate: An entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a
 party. "Control" means ownership of 50% or more of shares or equity interests with
 voting rights for electing directors or managing authority.
- Company (referred to as "We", "Us", or "Our"): Refers to NGO, Tbilisi, 0144.
- **Cookies**: Small files placed on your device by a website, containing browsing history details or other uses.
